2017-2018 Indoor JOAD Season

Tournament Schedule:

Clubs have until the first week of August to confirm and firm up dates, but this is the tentative tournament schedule. This year will be a 6 month indoor season to more closely align with what takes place on the national level.

October 21-22 - Hosted by Youth Archery Academy (Highland Ranch)

November 11-12 - Hosted by High Altitude Hitmen (Longmont)

December 16-17 - Hosted by Aslan Archery (location TBD)

January 13-14 - Hosted by Empty Quiver (Location TBD)

February 3-4 - Hosted by 5280 Archers (Highlands Ranch)

March 17-18 - Hosted by Archery School of the Rockies (Colorado Springs)

Tournament Registration Fee: Standard JOAD Rotational registration fees will be set at \$30 per archer, \$25 for additional family members with a family maximum of \$80

Shooter of the year – The Shooter of the Year for 2017-2018 will receive the coveted Belt Buckle award! This prize will be awarded to the shooter of the year based on their consistent performance throughout the season. There will be a point system closely matching the National Ranking system used by USA Archery. Here is the basis for Shooter of the year:

Ranking for Shooter of the year:

Shooters will be awarded points based on how they finish in each tournament. One point for first place, 2 points for second place, 3 for third, etc. Their two best finishes plus their finish in the State championship will determine their total "ranking score" for the season. The shooter with the lowest "ranking score" at the end will be awarded the buckle and title of "shooter of the year"

- 1. Eligible shooters must participate in a MINIMUM of 4 out of the 6 events during the season
- 2. Eligible shooters must participate in the Colorado Indoor State Championship which will be used as one of their 3 qualifying finishes
- 3. Eligible shooters must participate in a minimum of 2 additional <u>tournaments in</u> <u>the same class and division</u> as the state championship. ie. Ranking scores will only be used from events where the archer is shooting in the division that they shot during the championship
- 4. Archers who compete in all 6 tournaments during the season will receive a bonus of -1 point.
- 5. Any division ending in a tied ranking score at the end of the season will be resolved through a one arrow shoot-off at the end of the State Championship

State Champion Title: State Champion will be the winner of the tournament in March (The Colorado JOAD State Championship). The Custom USA Archery State championship medals will be given out at this event.
